

Important Facts regarding GLASS and PAINT

Fact #1

Glass tanks never need to be recoated on the inside or the outside. Saying "it CAN'T be recoated" is a misnomer because it will never "NEED" to be recoated.

Fact # 2

Epoxy painted tank coatings can be Rolled, Brushed, Baked (at the temperature of a loaf of bread), Sprayed, Robotically applied, electrostatically applied ... it doesn't matter. **Paint is Paint.** Cover it with liquid, cover it with powder, even cover it with plastic wrap....Paint MUST be recoated. Saying "it CAN be recoated" is deceiving because it will "HAVE" to be recoated. And the recoat will be field applied under field conditions by a local painting contractor, not the tank manufacturer, using the same paint as ANY painted tank and NOT some "miracle paint". ** Be sure to confirm that your tank has enough corrosion allowance so it actually can be repainted

Fact #3

A name is just a name....and a name does not make a better product. A name does not even make a good product. A name is just something that someone decided to call something. Could be they liked the name, could be they wanted to confuse people, but in the end, a name is just a name.
